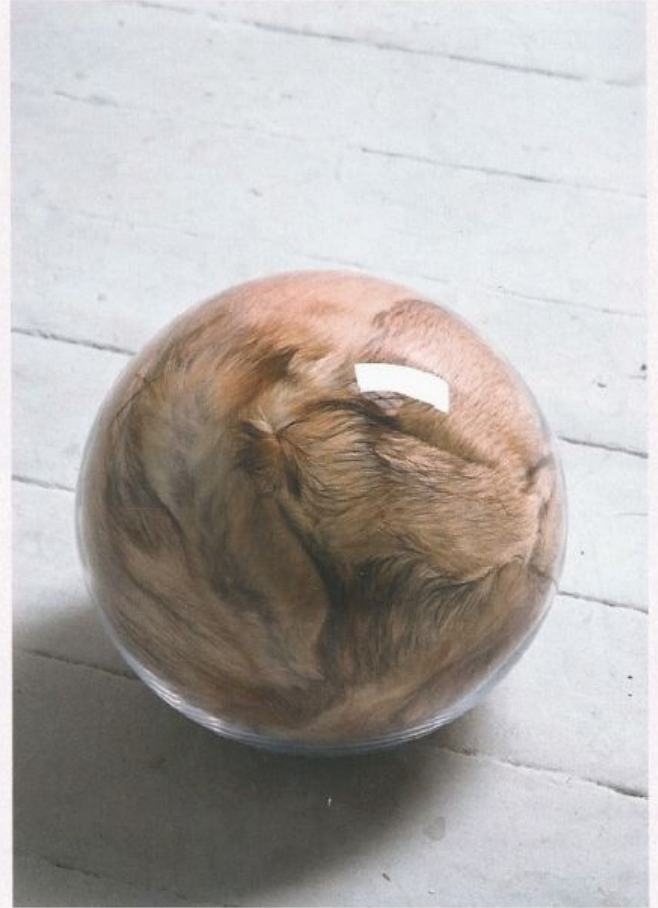

Description: The transition from art school to art world is a difficult one for many of the UK's art students to negotiate, and today's climate of funding cuts for both institutions and universities has not made it any easier. In its sixth year, the prize provides graduates with visibility in a saturated scene.

Exhibiting artists include: Gabriella Boyd (Glasgow School of Art), Poppy Bisdee (Wimbledon College of Art), Jonny Briggs (Royal College of Art), Max Dovey (Wimbledon College of Art), Ali Kazim (Slade School of Fine Art), Adeline de Monseignat (City and Guilds of London), Scheila Sokhanvari (Goldsmiths) and Julia Vogl (Slade School of Fine Art).

Note that the winner will be selected by a panel of judges and awarded a £5,000 prize, while for the first time there will be a separate award determined by a public vote.
